Dear Resident,

As another step in our continuing program to meet our customer's needs and to anticipate their future requirements, we will be making improvements to the underground facilities that supply electricity to your homes in your area. The work is scheduled to begin on or about Monday, October 9, 2017. We do not anticipate electric service to your house being interrupted during this construction period.

Our contractor, **Henkels & McCoy, Inc.** will be replacing the underground electric wires in your neighborhood. Our contractor will be using a directional boring technology that will have minimal disturbance to your property. There may be situations where trenching is required due to unknown soil conditions. The contractor will install top soil and seed for new grass in any disturbed areas. All restoration work will be provided by our contractor Henkels & McCoy, Inc.

For all lawn/property restoration related questions please call Henkels & McCoy – phone number 1-609-387-9000.

As we install our new cables they are typically coiled up next to our transformers and may remain that way for several days until we can de-energize our old cables and energize the newly installed cables. To energize the new cables we need room to safely work on our transformers. We require at least 8 feet of space from the front and 3 feet from the sides and rear of the transformer (please see the transformer sticker sample on page 2). This may require the removal of existing shrubs, landscaping, fences, etc. within those access requirements. We would appreciate your cooperation with removing those obstacles in advance of our work. Keep in mind, there are buried electric cables that run to the transformers and back to the houses, so please make sure you call 1-800-272-1000 before you do any digging. It's the Law. In addition, if you have any privately owned underground facilities such as an underground sprinkler system, invisible fence, septic field, oil tank, drain, etc., have them marked out prior to the start of work so the crews will be aware of them.

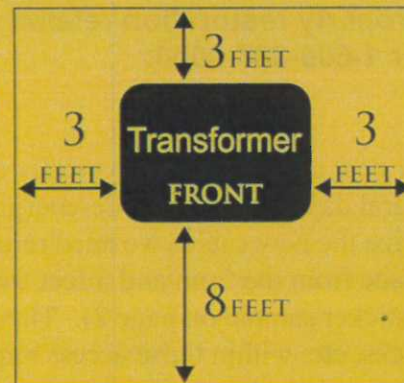
