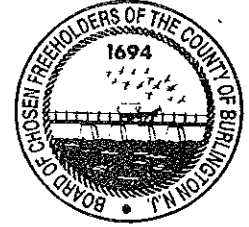

Proposed Intersection Improvements Creek Road and Masonville Road Mount Laurel Township, Burlington County

Meeting Purpose: The purpose of this public information center is to inform local residents, business owners and the traveling public about Burlington County's plans to improve the intersection of Creek Road and Masonville Road. Staff from the Burlington County Engineering Department and the design consultant will be available to answer questions. Comments from the public are welcome.

Project Background: Masonville Road (CR 635) and the eastbound Creek Road (CR 636) approach are county roadways, and the westbound Creek Road approach is a municipal roadway. This intersection experiences significant delays in the morning and evening peak hours due to conflicting traffic movements from motorists travelling from Masonville Road to Creek Road and I-295, and vice versa. The County is proposing to improve the horizontal and vertical alignments of this intersection, as well as mitigate the traffic congestion and drainage issues.

Preferred Improvement Alternative: The County is proposing to realign Masonville Road and the eastbound approach of Creek Road with a continuous horizontal curve. The westbound Creek Road approach will form a T-intersection. A new fully actuated traffic signal will continue to control right-of-way at this location. The proposed intersection realignment will improve safety, move current and future traffic volumes at an acceptable level of service, and address the existing concerns at the intersection, including drainage issues. The preferred alternative produces minimum right-of-way impacts and also accommodates pedestrians at the intersection.

Construction Schedule: Construction is likely to occur in 2011.
