

REQUEST FOR BIDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received by the Township of Mount Laurel, New Jersey, for the

Open Space Demolition Project 2011

in the Township of Mount Laurel, in the County of Burlington until 10:00 AM prevailing time on Thursday, December 15, 2011 at which time the bids will be opened and publicly read in the Mount Laurel Municipal Building at 100 Mount Laurel Road, Mount Laurel, New Jersey.

The project includes the demolition and clearing of multiple structures and debris in their entirety on a single property within the Township of Mount Laurel.

Bid documents for the proposed work, prepared by Kenneth P. Morrison Jr., have been filed in the Office of the Township Manager, located at 100 Mt. Laurel Rd Mount Laurel, New Jersey 08054 and may be inspected by prospective bidders during normal business hours, Monday through Friday, 8:00AM to 4:00PM. Bidders may obtain copies of the Bid Documents from the office of the Township Manager upon a non-refundable payment of \$50.00.

Proposals must be made on the standard Proposal Form, in the manner designated therein and required by the Specification. The proposals must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the contract description on the outside, and addressed to: Office of the Township Clerk, Mount Laurel Township, 100 Mount Laurel Road, Mount Laurel, NJ 08054.

Please submit your Letter of Federal Approval or your New Jersey Certificate of Employee Information Report with this bid. If you do not have either document, you will be required to complete and submit Affirmative Action Employee Information Report (AA302). Form (AA302) is available from the County of Burlington.

Each bid must be accompanied by a Non—Collusion Affidavit, an Ownership Disclosure Form, Department of Labor Contractor Registration Certificate, State of New Jersey Business Registration Certification, and a proposal guaranty in the form of a certified check or bid bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the Total Price Bid in the proposal; except that when the Total Price Bid is \$200,000.00 or more, the amount of the proposal guaranty shall be \$20,000.00. The proposal guaranty must be in the form of a bid bond, or certified check, or cashier's check or a combination thereof, and must be drawn to the order of the Township of Mount Laurel, and must be delivered at the place and by the hour above-named.

If awarded a contract your firm/company will be required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975 c.127 (NJAC17.27).
