

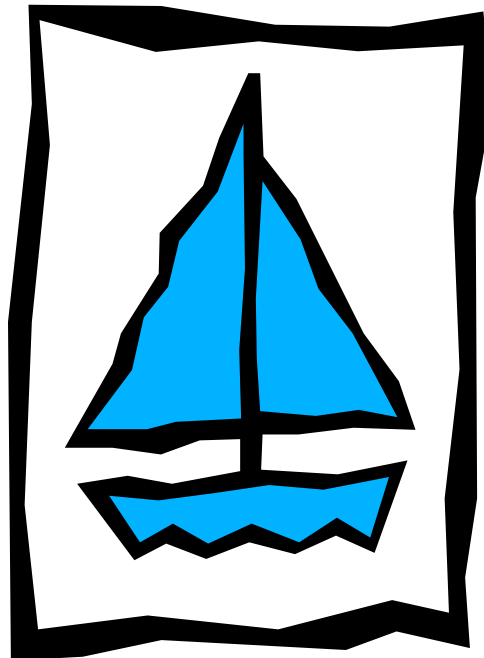

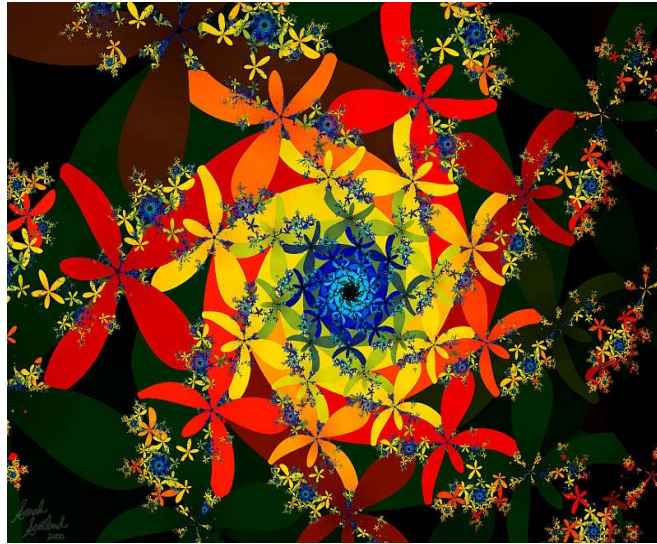


FRIDAY AFTERNOON MATINEE MOVIES
