

List of Important Dates:

- January 10th The Annual Assessment List is filed with the Burlington County Board of Taxation.
- February 1st Assessor shall notify each taxpayer by mail of the current assessment and preceding year's taxes.
- This notification should not be used for Income Tax purposes.
- April 1st Taxpayers and taxing districts may appeal the Assessed Valuation to the Burlington County Board of Taxation.
- Where the assessed valuation exceeds \$750,000, the taxpayer or taxing district may file a complaint directly with the NJ State Tax Court.
- July 1st Farmland Applications are mailed to all properties designated as qualified farmland.
- August 1st All owners of farmland claiming to have their land assessed under the Farmland Assessment Act must file an application (Form FA-1) with the assessor.
- October 1st Assessor must file the Added Assessment List with the Burlington County Board of Taxation.
- October 1st Assessor mails to all Class 4 owners the request to provide the annual income and expenses associated with the property.
- November 1st All new applicants for a property tax exemption must file an Initial Statement. If an exemption has been granted for past years, the applicant must file a Further Statement by November 1st of every third year.
- December 1st Appeals from added assessments or omitted assessments may be made to the Burlington County Board of Taxation.
- December 31st Legal Advertisement – where and when the tax list may be inspected by any taxpayer to ascertain what assessments have been made, and to confer informally with the assessor as to the correctness of the assessments, so that any errors may be corrected before filing of the assessment list.
