At a Mount Laurel Township Council Meeting on March 25, 2019, Mayor Kurt Folcher addressed the public during the council comments portion of the meeting and informed the public that the Township Manager and he met with Assemblywoman Murphy regarding multiple DOT projects slated to take place in Mount Laurel. The Mayor stated that during the meeting with Assemblywoman Murphy he explained the impact traffic has on Mount Laurel Township residents and commercial businesses. He also explained how important the 295 ramp project off of Route 38 and the Church Road/Ramblewood Parkway project are to Mount Laurel Township. Assemblywoman Murphy was provided all the information necessary as to where the project currently stands and the last correspondence the Township had received from the State of New Jersey. Assemblywoman Murphy agreed with the Mayor on the importance of these improvements happening in Mount Laurel Township. Mayor Folcher thanked Assemblywoman Murphy for her attention on this important issue. Assemblywoman Murphy stated her office would arrange a meeting the second week of April with the DOT, her office, and the Township of Mount Laurel to be hosted at the Municipal Building. The Township is looking forward to Assemblywoman Murphy contacting the Township with the date and time of this meeting.
